MATERIALS LIST

The \$75 materials fee for the class covers printing inks and some Rives BFK paper. Additional materials needed:

- Brushes
 - watercolor brushes #3, #6 rounds
 - bristle oil painting brushes flats and rounds #4 and #6 (or your preferred sizes)
- Drawing pad for sketching and notes
- Pencils
- Plexiglas: 1/8 inch (clear acrylic sheet) in your preferred sizes: 8x10, 9x12, 16x24...

Can also be larger: 18 x 24 in. 24 x 32 in.(If you want to print on a full sheet of 22x30 paper)

There is also a hardware store nearby to get more sizes., (and I can cut other sizes for you)

• Woodcut blocks in sizes same as Plexiglas, such as Shina plywood (McClains) or ¼ inch luan (local lumber yard).

We can also supply some luan wood and cut down for you.

- Woodcarving Tools (There are some available from Renaissance Graphic Arts online)

 - individual v-gouge
 - individual U-gouge
 - individual wide gouge

- Oil paints in various colors
- Watercolor paints in tubes
- Japanese papers: kitikata and mulberry (source: Hiromi paper)
- Soft pastels (not oil pastels)
- More Cotton rag paper: Arches cover white, Somerset velvet (white or soft white), etc.
