MATERIALS LIST

The \$75 materials fee for the class covers printing inks and some Rives BFK paper. Additional materials needed:

- Newsprint paper pad 18 x24 in (purchase a pad that has at least 25 sheets or more-this will come in handy during printing.)
- 2 sheets of Mulberry or Kozo paper (preferably a thinner grade of paper: between 10 gms – 25gsm)
- Alternative sources for mulberry paper: anything between 10gsm to 25gsm in weight is acceptable.

- Roll or pad of tracing paper (for image transfer, and rubbings of relief matrix)
- Acetate (1 sheet 24 x 36 in)
- 1 sheet of Chipboard or Mat board (You can also use the board from the back of your drawing pad)

- Roll of masking tape or artist tape
- Brushes (synthetic hair): any assortment and they do not have to be fancy
- Pack/box of gloves (optional)
- Glue (PVA glue is Preferable: Jade 403 glue or the brand Lineco)
- Scissors
- X-Acto knife or utility knife with snap-off replacement blades
- Ruler
- 1 tube of Titanium white acrylic paint
- 1 bottle or tube of black acrylic paint (can be student grade)
- Gel Medium: liquitex acrylic heavy gloss gel medium or Golden brand heavy gel medium. (If you already have heavy gel medium and it is in a mat finish that will work fine as well)
- Sandpaper (Optional: various grits to experiment with)
- Eraser: 1 White eraser (vinyl eraser), 1 gum eraser, 1 kneaded eraser
- Small container with lids (yogurt containers will suffice)
- Waterproof Sharpie markers (broad and fine felt tip)
- Pencils
- Watercolor or gouache or any kind of water-soluble medium you prefer
- Graphite stick 2B or 4B (please do not purchase compressed graphite)
- Magazines, and any materials that are appropriate for collaging (Fabric, lace, onion/garlic bags, feathers, textured paper etc)
