## MATERIALS LIST

- Watercolors in tube - please try to obtain higher quality colors from brands such as Windsor and Newton Artists, or Windsor and Newton Cotman, Holbein, or Van Gogh
- Cadmium Red
- Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Yellow (Medium)
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Cerulean Blue
- Burnt Umber
- Burnt Sienna
- Hookers Green
- Yellow Ochre
- Sap Green
- Plastic water container that can hold at least 2.5 quarts with a big open mouth (likely found at a hardware store)
- Graphite pencil
- Kneaded eraser or white gum eraser
- Round tip watercolor brushes \#2, \#6, and \#12 Synthetic or Sable
- $11 \times 15$ " or larger plastic rectangular watercolor palette (12 or more wells) with cover

A large flat mixing area is crucial in your selection. The bigger the better with enough wells for all the colors in your possession

- 2 or more pieces of HOT PRESS WHITE watercolor paper ( $22 \times 30$ ")

All paper comes with a surface description of rough, hot press or cold press. Choose a brand such as Fabriana or Fabriana Artistico 140lb-300lb, Strathmore 140-300lb, Arches 140lb-300lb
