MATERIALS LIST

• Drawing Paper: There is an extraordinary range of drawing paper available at good art stores. I have found BLICK to be an art supply store that can be relied on for both range and quality of materials. If anyone is traveling from a distant state where art supplies are difficult to obtain I would be willing to purchase the 18x24" drawing pad for them and be reimbursed later.

I would suggest buying: 4x sheets of 'Archers' paper, size: 22x30". You may of course consider buying a larger quantity as these are only guidelines and suggestions.

Please feel free to make your own choices according to your drawing experience, access to materials, and your budget.

- 1 Blick Drawing Pad 18x24" (NOT newsprint)
- Pencils: H, B, 2B one of each
- Vine Charcoal: 4 large round sticks
- Vine Charcoal: 5 medium sticks
- Compressed Charcoal: 4 sticks
- Blick Acrylic White 150ml one tube only
- Blick Acrylic Black 150 ml one tube only
- Palette any kind of palette that you may be using. A white plastic or china plate would function equally well.
- 2 Containers to hold water: glass or plastic jars, or tin cans will do.
- Bristle Brush: Round #4 and #8 please bring along additional brushes from your own collection.
- 1 Bottle of black ink
- Masking tape 1"
- Notebook/Journal Size is optional, but preferably not too small as you should be able to make small sketches if the need arises.

Please feel free to bring along any additional materials that you may want to use. Color may be an important consideration for you, in which case acrylic paint, watercolor, gouache, colored
